§1. Meeting starts

§7. Information

a. Update on current status of the Strategic Research Areas (SRAs)

Gunnar Gouras gave an update on the recent meetings with vice chancellor office, Faculty of Medicine and other SRAs. The information from the meeting at the vice chancellor office September 22nd, is that the budget will stay the same for 2016, which means an additional funding year directly to MultiPark.

b. New Steering Group

The Coordinators have delegated to the 7 translational groups to elect/select a representant and a deputy from each group. In addition, a movement disorders representative and a deputy from the neurology clinic have been elected by the movement disorders neurologists.

§8. Budget

a. Discussion on future budget 2016

Pia Berntsson gave a review of the basic principles of the budget for 2016. It was *decided* to draft a budget on basic principles presented during the meeting. The drafted budget will support the project office, professor salaries and other ongoing funding to different degrees. The board voted in favor of the proposed budget, including administration, research school, travel grants and other strategic grants; among these there was an increase in funds for travel grants, while innovation grants will now be included in other strategic grants. In addition, since the university indicated that they will no longer provide support for an innovation officer, this cost item was removed from the 2016 budget. Support of the SIA initiative was described as a new means of stimulating Innovation in our environment. The final decision of the detailed budget will be made at the next board meeting.

b. Decision regarding extending (or prolonging) 2015 funding into 2016

It was *decided* to postpone the decision about extension of the start package (Per Odin) into 2016 until the next board meeting in December this year. Per

Odin will be asked to provide more information to the board regarding the reason for not using the funding.

It was **decided** to extend the funding period for translational group 3 into 2016 regarding the workshop that was granted 90,688 SEK. Johan Jakobsson left the room during the decision process due to declared conflict of interest.

It was *decided* to extend the funding period into 2016 of the allocated sum to infrastructure (PET scanners) for translational group 5 and 6 (1,881,376 SEK) Oskar Hansson left the room during the decision process due to declared conflict of interest. In addition, it was suggested to invite Freddy Ståhlberg, Director of Lund Biolmaging Center, to the next board meeting to discuss the PET purchase and the most feasible approach for the funding allocated by MultiPark. In addition, there was also a discussion about add-on funding for the PET scanners during 2016.

It was *decided* to support additional salary support (6 months; 50%) to Tomas Björklund and Laurent Roybon, whose junior positions ended this year and at the beginning of next year. The salary supports need to be initiated immediately if the position has ended or in immediate connection with the ending of the position and be used before the end of 2016. In addition, it was decided that the other three young scientists supported by MultiPark should also be able to apply for similar one-time bridging funds in the future. However, the general goal is to have only open calls in the future.

§9. Other issues

The present board members were informed that the MultiPark board needs to be extended into the next year – 2016. The board members will be contacted by the Faculty of Medicine or "Doktorandkåren". In addition, one should investigate the possibilities to appoint deputies for the MultiPark board.
