§1. Meeting starts

§7. Information – update from the management

a) Graduate school (enclosure 3)

Maria Björkqvist, Study Coordinator at MultiPark Neuroscience Graduate School, gave an update about the ongoing activities and future activities within the graduate school.

- Lunch seminar series is an ongoing biweekly event and innovation talk has been added to the series
- Preparatory course (20 wks; 30 ECTS) has been approved June 7th and is announced on June 8th. The course will start in January 2017. The course will cost approximate 200,000 SEK for MultiPark whereof ca. 100,000 SEK will be costs for the course leader. One option is that one could also pay 10,000 SEK per student to PIs acting as supervisors during project work. One will start to include 10 students at the national level before going international.

This course could be a first step towards a master in Neuroscience. The board suggested a transparent process and information for the course in order to avoid any doubt about the purpose and content of the course.

b) Innovation update

The innovation groups has been revived with several new members and chair: Tomas Deierborg (chair), Thomas Laurell, Tomas Björklund, Lars Grundemar, Gunnar Gouras, Agnete Kirkeby. The group will continue with the innovation grants and has added innovation talks to the seminar series to expose the younger researcher to innovation at an early stage in their career. It was suggested to measure outcome from the innovation activities. The group is currently lacking innovation manager but one could consider to try this next year.

The persons involved in the strategic innovation agenda supported by MultiPark and VINNOVA last year have initiated an innovation network at the national level – BrainGain Sweden – www.braingainsweden.org that will have their first network meeting August 31st – September 1st at Lidingö. SWElife is sponsoring part of the event.

c) Centre process

The Coordinators of MultiPark met with Gunilla Westergren-Thorsson, Dean Faculty of Medicine and Hannie Lundgren Research Director at Region Skåne as well as head of neurology Jesper Pettersson and Johan Jakobsson, Coordinator of Bagadilico, on June 8th before the board meeting. All participants were positive to the idea and criteria for centre formation will be available in a couple of days. The application process can start as soon as the criteria are known.

§8. Decision

a) Co-funding TRANSEURO (enclosure 4)

It was *decided* to co-fund TRANSEURO with 1,000,000 SEK (including indirect costs) for 2016 despite not fulfilling the original criteria as stated in the budget for 2016. David Brooks refrained from taking part in the decision.



§9. Other issues

David Brooks will move to UK and might not be available during the meetings in the autumn. It was suggested to reduce the number board meetings per year, from four to three per year since there are fewer major/financial decisions in the spring term.
