- §7. Decision budget item
 - a. purchase of confocal microscope

It was *decided* to maintain the steering group for the A11 confocal. For 3 working days give access to the A11 microscope to all trained MultiPark users with the same principles of usage as for the new A13 confocal. Training should occur on the other 2 working days. The aim is to get a similar system on A13, which will make training and usage on both microscopes more efficient. If these condition are met, the new confocal will be purchased.

b. reallocate of funds for NGS from bioinformatics to LUNARC storage

The board *decided* to approve the request to reallocate part of the bioinformatics salary support (200 000 SEK) to LUNARC storage rent. The percentage of the bioinformatician will be reduced to 20% in the year 2018 and adjusted back to 40% in 2019. Other MultiPark platforms will also be able to use the storage space.

§8. Infrastructure reporting

Anna-Karin Ekman presented the results of the infrastructure survey.
