- §7. Information update from the management
 - a) Infrastructure survey

The letter of concern from Bagadilico was discussed and addressed. Preparation of MultiPark steering documents has been initiated (§7c) and questions to the behavioral platform (§8) were clarified. Malin Parmar was invited participant for this issue and the board appreciated the open dialogue. It was suggested to invite the steering group members to join in on the lunch that usually takes place before the actual board meeting, to have the possibility to interact with the board and also to combine this with shorter talks that would facilitate interactions across MultiPark members.
