Meeting starts

Susanne Iwarsson welcomes everyone and opens the meeting. She informs the Board that she has to leave early, and Gunnar Gouras will then take over and chair the meeting.

Designation of "Justeringsperson"

Håkan Billig is assigned together with the Chair of the Board to approve the minutes.

Approval of the agenda § 3.

The Board approves the agenda. From the latest board meeting it was decided to bring up an issue raised by Hjalmar Bjartmarz regarding the environment at the clinic. Provided Hjalmar Bjartmarz arrives to attend the meeting, this issue will be discussed under §11.

Minutes from the latest board meetings

The Board approves the minutes from the latest board meeting (May 7th 2014). Susanne Iwarsson comments on what is written in §9, that there would be an overarching discussion regarding infrastructure at the next board meeting. However, since MultiPark has not received a report from the infrastructure working group, such a discussion will not be possible and has to be postponed.

Delegated decisions (enclosure 1)

The Travel Grants that have been approved by the Coordinator and Assistant coordinator are summarized in the table in Enclosure 1. Also included in the

enclosure is the delegated decision made by the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine in July 2014, for additional funds of 2.5 MSEK within the call for Investments for Strategic Development.

§ 6. Per capsulam decisions

On June 17th 2014, it was decided per capsulam by the MultiPark Board to:

 use SEK 2.5 million for additional funding of translational research projects submitted in response to the call issued in early 2014

 to assign the external board members with the task to propose the distribution of funds based on their earlier ranking, for decision by the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine (because of conflicts of interest in the Board). See §5.

§ 7. Information

Susanne Iwarsson gives the following information to the Board:

a. From strategic plan to action plan

There are two meetings planned during fall 2014 to discuss action plans based on the new strategic plan. The same group within MultiPark that worked on the strategic plan has been invited to these meetings, on October 8th and December 3rd.

b. MultiPark Conference planned for December 19th 2014 MultiPark is this year planning a one-day conference and Christmas party instead of a retreat. Emma Roybon gives an update from the working group in charge of the planning. The Board members are invited to attend the conference and an invitation will be sent out shortly.

c. MultiPark Day for the public in early 2015

Public relations officer Jens Persson is planning a MultiPark Day in March 2015, which will be focused on popular science presentation and open to the public.

d. SFO Anthology

Lund University has decided to write an anthology with contributions from all the SFOs at LU, to be distributed at the evaluation hearing in Stockholm on December 1st. Jens Persson has together with the coordinator and assistant coordinator written the contribution from MultiPark, and the chapter focuses on cell transplantation from the time of Arvid Carlsson's discovery of dopamine to the current Transeuro trial as well as the successes of converting skin cells to dopaminergic neurons.

e. Management of MultiPark from 2015 (coordination, administration and Board)

Susanne Iwarsson informs that she has notified the Vice Chancellor that she will not continue as coordinator for MultiPark as of January 1st 2015. Gunnar Gouras has accepted to take on the role as coordinator, which also the Vice Chancellor has approved. The process of assigning a new assistant coordinator will start shortly. The current mandate period of the Board ends on December 31st

2014. The management of the Faculty of Medicine wishes to prolong the mandate for the current members until December 31st 2015 provided that they state that they are available to serve on the Board for another year. Already, Sten-Magnus Aquilonius has informed that he wishes to resign from the Board. Susanne Iwarsson requests the Board members to reflect on whether they would like to remain on the Board for an additional year, and to notify her of their decision no later than October 15th 2014. Regarding management, Susanne Iwarsson informs that during fall 2014 the weekly meetings will continue, and different co-workers will be invited to these meetings depending on what will be discussed. Since Susanne Iwarsson will not be the coordinator as of 2015, it will be up to Gunnar Gouras to decide on the management structure from then on.

f. Evaluation of Linnaeus environment, BAGADILICO
The evaluation of BAGADILICO was very successful and the recommendation from the evaluators is to keep the funding at the same level for an additional five years.

g. Update on major grants A handout is provided with examples of major grants within MultiPark since May 2014.

§ 8. Budget issues

 a. Financial status per 2014-06-30
 Susanne Iwarsson informs the Board of the financial status by 2014-06-30.

b. Prognosis for 2014
Susanne Iwarsson informs that according to the current forecast for 2014 there will be a surplus of 414 KSEK in the budget. The MultiPark management has prepared a suggestion to use this surplus for support for PhD student salary funding. The Board agrees with this suggestion and it is decided to:

 promptly announce a call to fund PhD salary, based on the format and principles in use by the Faculty of Medicine.

- delegate to the Coordinator to execute the decision process, together with the Assistant Coordinator. Principally, all the applications that meet a set of eligibility criteria will be approved. The total amount to be granted will be based on the estimated surplus by the end of October 2014, and divided among the applicants based on their requests for 50% or 100% salary coverage during Nov-Dec 2014. For those PhD students who are already fully funded by MultiPark during 2014 no such funding can be transferred to forthcoming years and are thus not eligible for the new call. That is, all the funding granted based on this new call must be used no later than Dec 31, 2014.
- c. Report from meeting with the Dean and Faculty Office representatives

Susanne Iwarsson informs the Board of a meeting she had along with the coordinators from the other SFOs from the Faculty of

Medicine with the Dean and Faculty Office representatives where budget issues were discussed for 2015. The general approach from all environments was to invest in research infrastructure and personnel. The message from the Dean was that the SFOs could budget similarly to previous years. However no decisions should be made that extends into 2016. There could still be preparations for the announcement of new positions, even for ratification by the Faculty Board during spring 2015. Once there is more information regarding future funding for the SFOs, such plans can be effectuated in the form of announcements.

d. Budget 2015

Susanne Iwarsson presents the draft for the budget for 2015 and reminds the Board of the strategic plan and of the upcoming meetings on the action plan. Based on the content of the strategic plan, the management suggests new items in the budget; 2 MSEK for support packages for PhD student salaries; 2 MSEK for various positions below professor's level (salaries for research positions, start-up packages); and 2.5 MSEK for infrastructure investments. The issue of start-up packages for new recruits at junior level is discussed as an option to be combined with other funding sources, receiving strong support by the Board. Furthermore Susanne Iwarsson informs that the Vice Chancellor will most likely discontinue the 25% salary support for an innovation manager for MultiPark. Also, since there will be no more reporting or evaluation, the amount of administration needed has decreased. An option raised by the Board would be to redistribute the salary support from administration to an innovation manager. The issue regarding granting an additional 30% salary support for Roger Olsson so that he would receive 100% salary until November 30th 2015 is discussed. The Board supports such a post in the budget for 2015. Summing up on this, overall the Board supports the draft budget for 2015 as presented and encourages the coordinator and management team to prepare for a budget decision along these lines, considering also the input from MultiPark co-workers during the upcoming action plan meetings.

§ 9. Report on ParkReg

Gunnar Gouras chairs the meeting and it is concluded from the report from Per Odin that Sven Pålhagen will continue as "delregisterhållare" for the Swedish Parkinson Registry. He will as of November 1st 2014, receive 20% salary support from the Swedish Parkinson Academy. The plan is that he will continue this assignment until June 2015, when Per Odin has announced his interest in taking over the responsibility. This decision will be taken by the Board of SWEMODIS.

§ 10. Report on Innovation Agenda proposal, Lennart Gisselsson MultiPark's Innovation Manager Lennart Gisselsson reports on the ongoing work to submit an application for an Innovation Agenda to Vinnova.

TILLDELNING AV YTTERLIGARE MEDEL FÖR UTLYSNINGEN "INVESTMENTS FOR STRATEGIC DEVELOPMENT" INOM DET STRATEGISKA FORSKNINGSOMRÅDET MULTIPARK

Mot bakgrund av att ytterligare medel finns att tillgå, fattade MultiParks styrelse via email beslutet att delegera till de externa styrelseledamöterna att rekommendera ytterligare medel till utlysningen "Investments for strategic development" för de som redan blivit beviljade medel. Flertal av de interna representanterna i styrelsen för MultiPark är jäviga och MultiParks styrelse därmed inte är beslutsför för fördelning av anslag till "Investments for strategic development 2014" och därför har Medicinska fakultetsstyrelsen delegerat till dekanus att fatta beslutet. Syftet med mejlkonversationen var att ta fram en rekommendation till dekanus inför beslutet.

Totalt beviljades 16 ansökningar i mars 2014 totalsumman 4 830 000 SEK. Styrelsen för MultiPark hade avsatt total 4 miljoner SEK för finansiering av "Investments for strategic development" 2014 och ytterligare medel på 830 000 SEK fanns att tillgå. De extra medel som finns att tillgå till ytterligare fördelning i juni/juli 2014 uppgår till 2,5 miljoner SEK.

Efter föredragning och diskussion rekommenderar granskarna/externa styrelsemedlemmar (Sten-Magnus Aquilonius, Håkan Billig, Leif Østergaard, Björn Hellkvist) att nedanstående ansökningar beviljas anslag enligt de föreslagna beloppen.
